Turn left out of hotel parking lot, southeast on Cloverleaf Pkwy. toward Concord Lake Rd./NC-3.
Turn right onto Concord Lake Rd./NC-3. Continue to follow NC-3 for 3.4 miles.
NC-3 becomes Branchview Dr. SE 2.3 miles. Branchview Dr. SE becomes Union Street S. 0.6 miles.
Turn slight left onto Warren Coleman Blvd./US-601 S. Continue to follow US-601 S. 0.3 miles.
Merge onto Highway 49N/NC-49 via the ramp on the left toward Asheboro. 3.1 miles.
Turn left onto Old Airport Rd.. Event Center on right.

Directions to the Event Site

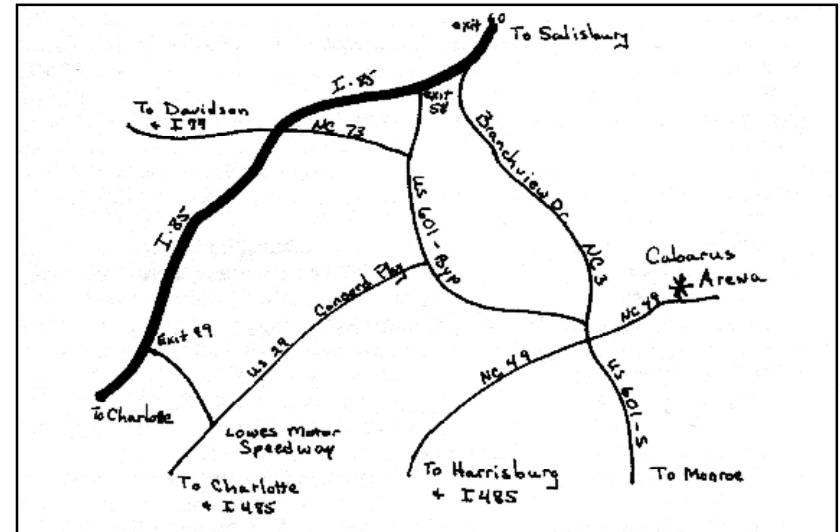
From Charlotte, Kings Mountain and Gastonia (via I-85): Take I-85 North to Exit 48 (I-485). Turn right on I-485 East, travel to NC 48 (Harrisburg). Turn left on 49 North, through Harrisburg—cross under US 601 (Bridge) and follow NC 49 3.2 miles. Arena will be on the left.

OR: Take I-485 East to Exit 33 (Hwy. 49N-Harrisburg). Stay on Hwy. 49 North for approximately 13.5 miles. Arena will be on the left.

From Asheboro: Travel NC 49 South, pass under NC 73 (bridge) and travel 2.9 miles. Arena will be on the right.

From Salisbury: Travel I-85 South take Exit 60. Turn left on Dale Earnhardt/Copperfield Blvd. Follow to NC 3 (approx. 1.5 miles). Turn left at the traffic light and follow NC 3 to US 601 (go through approximately 6 traffic lights). Turn left at traffic light onto NC 49 North and follow NC 49 3.2 miles. Arena will be on the left.

From Columbia, South Carolina: Take I-77 North to I-485 East to Exit 33 (Hwy. 49 North-Harrisburg). Stay on Hwy. 49 North for approximately 13.5 miles. Arena will be on the left.

Additional Information

Dogs need to be at the show only at the scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter unless required for further judging. **The judge is not required to wait for dogs.** It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called.

Exercise areas will be marked. These are the only places to exercise your dogs. Please keep these areas cleaned up with the equipment provided. If we are to have access to these facilities again, exhibitors and handlers **MUST** keep them clean.

There will be **no smoking** in the building. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner.

Parents must be responsible for children. Children must be kept under supervision at all times.

The show giving club, the event secretary, or their members or agents assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property; and further assume no responsibility for any injury to children not under control of their parents or guardians.

All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. No flexi-leads inside the show building. No dogs will be allowed on the grounds except those entered in the show.

Free admission. Parking is \$5.00/day. See special RV Parking information in premium.

No gasoline or diesel generators inside any building or within 100 feet of any area in which this dog show is conducted.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
